The world's first academic research conference is happening in the UK in September! SFCT, in association with the University of Hertfordshire, presents **Orienting Solutions 2013**.

SF work has been seen in the past as a neat practical twist for working with clients. This conference is about setting SF work in a wider landscape of ideas, to show this simple practice in a richer and more compelling light. The event is a co-production between the departments of philosophy and nursing/social work at UH and SFCT.

A great array of SF pioneers and researchers is already confirmed. Alasdair Macdonald, Gale Miller, Janet Bavelas, Rayya Ghul are all confirmed, along with leading philosophers including Dan Hutto and Daniele Moyal-Sharrock.




The course has many advantages for people seeking a top-class training in SF for organisational settings like coaching, team development, OD and change management:


